- Quality and clarity of the applicant's response to the essay question.
- Confidential recommendations from a faculty member and a community resource person (using the Honors Recommendation Form).

Special consideration will be given to applicants involved in Service Learning, Campus Ministry, and other University or University club sponsored events.

No student may receive this award more than once while a student at Mount St. Joseph University.
