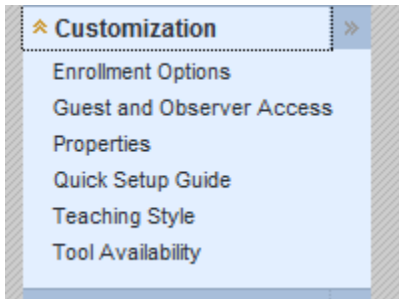


How to customize the appearance of your course menu


1. Click on “Customization” in the blue **Course Management Area** on the bottom left of your Blackboard course screen to expand the options there.
2. Click “Teaching Style”



3. By default your Course Menu Style is set to “Text” with a yellow background and blue text

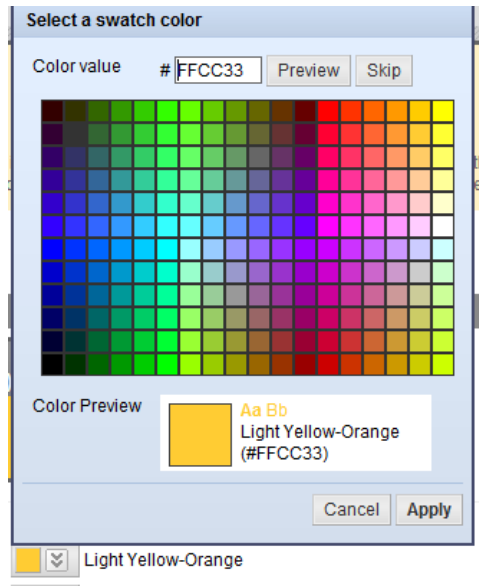

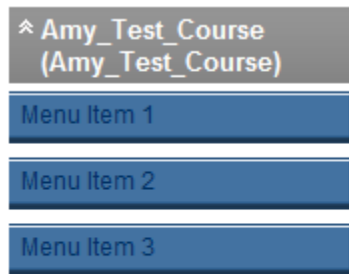

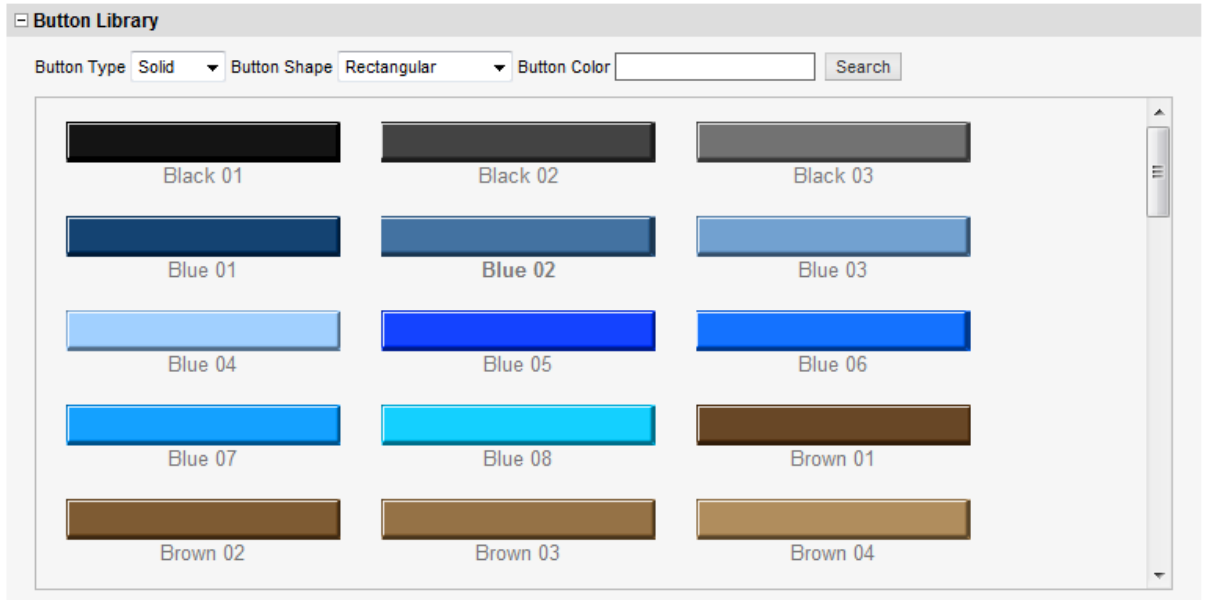


- To alter the color and style of the Buttons open up the “Button Library”

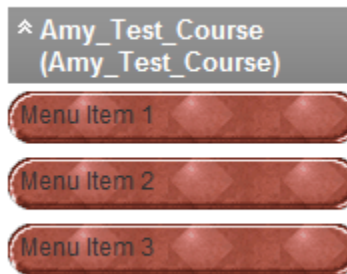
- Opening the “Button Library” gives you a variety of Button Type (Solid, Pattern, Striped) and Button Shape (Rectangle, Rounded Corners, Rounded Ends). Each type and shape can be adjusted and you have many color options available for your buttons.
