

IV. STUDENT RIGHTS & RESPONSIBILITIES

CLASSROOM

1. PROTECTION OF FREEDOM OF EXPRESSION

Consistent with the conduct expectations of students set forth in the Student Handbook, students are free to take reasoned exception to the data or views offered in any course of study and to reserve judgment about matters of opinion, but they are responsible for learning the content of any course of study for which they are enrolled.

2. PROTECTION AGAINST IMPROPER ACADEMIC EVALUATION

Students have due process protections through orderly procedures as directed by the Provost, against prejudiced or capricious academic evaluation. Students are also responsible for maintaining standards of academic performance established for each course in which they are enrolled.
