

# President's Cabinet

The President's Cabinet is selected and chaired by the President and consists of administrative officers representing all areas of University life. The Cabinet addresses issues that affect the entire University. It is charged with framing policy and procedures, making recommendations to the President, ensuring that informed decisions are reached through cross-functional discussion and with respect to the shared governance decision grid, and ensuring that such decisions are effectively communicated and implemented. The Cabinet is charged with aligning the University's strategic plan and available resources to ensure that the University is sustainable as it fulfills its mission. President's Cabinet demonstrates a commitment to the [Philosophy and Practice of Shared Governance](#) working collaboratively with the Board of Trustees and its committees toward strong alignment around and commitment to institutional, mission-driven direction and priorities.
