

Recording Webcam Video in Blackboard

You will need a webcam and microphone on your computer to use this feature. A YouTube account is also required.

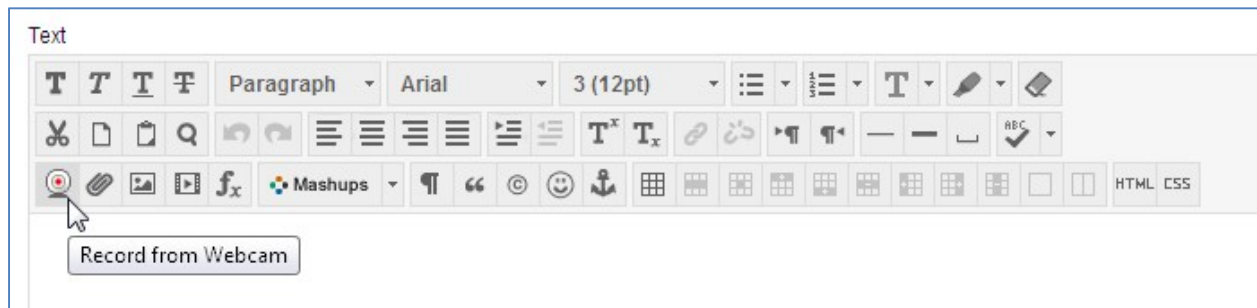
To create a YouTube account, you'll need to sign up from the following Google site:

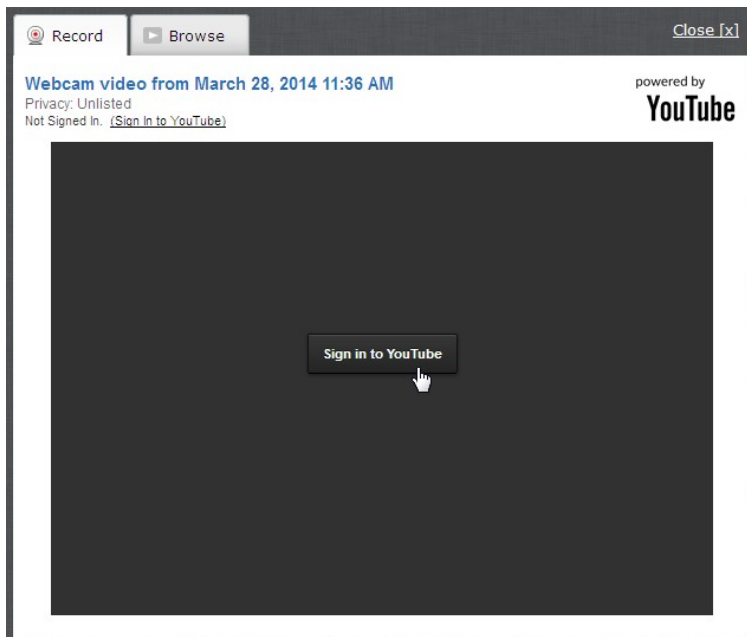
You can either use your pre-existing e-mail address or create a new Gmail account. It takes you step-by-step through the set up.

Log into Blackboard to access your course and navigate to the content area where the video will be added.

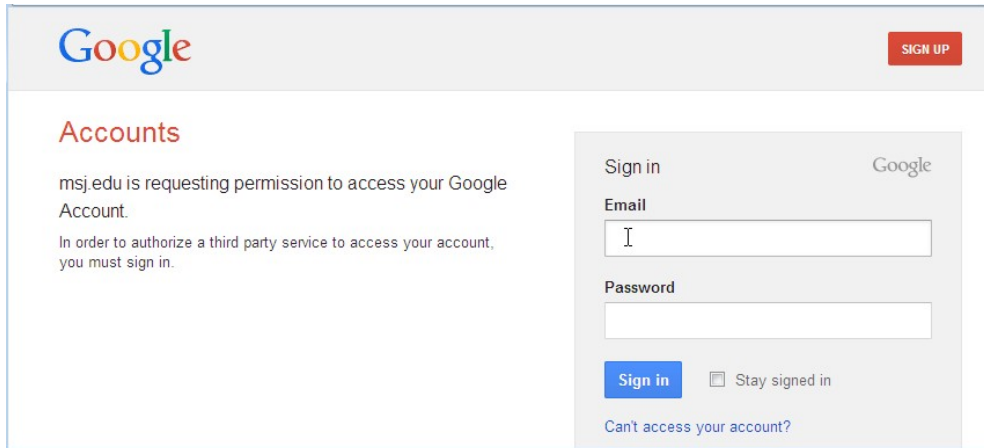
1. Click the **Record from Webcam** icon in the Text Editor.



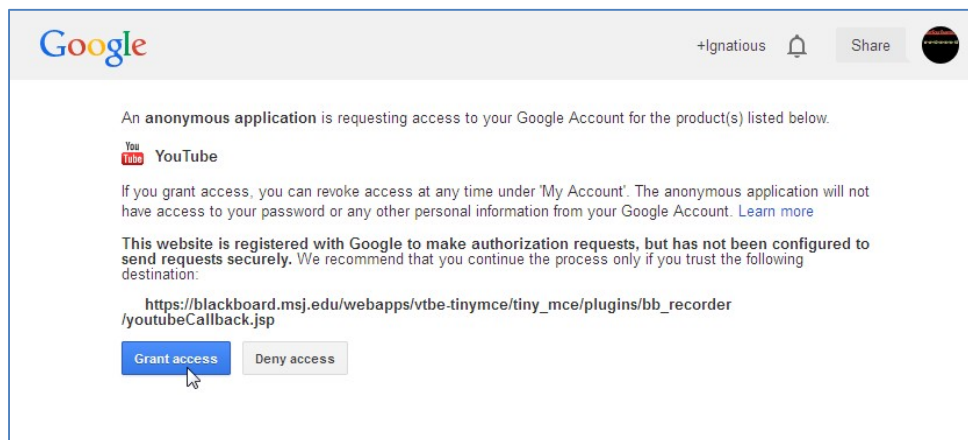
2. Click **Sign in to Youtube** in the Record window.



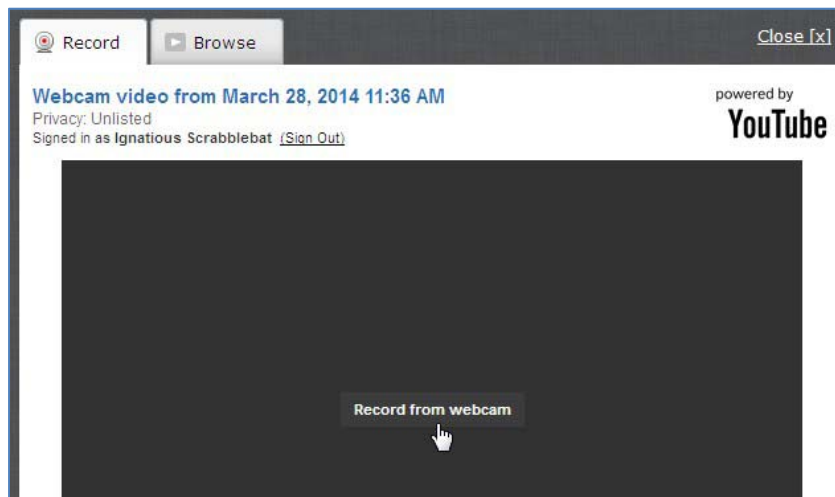
3. Sign in to your Youtube (Google) account.



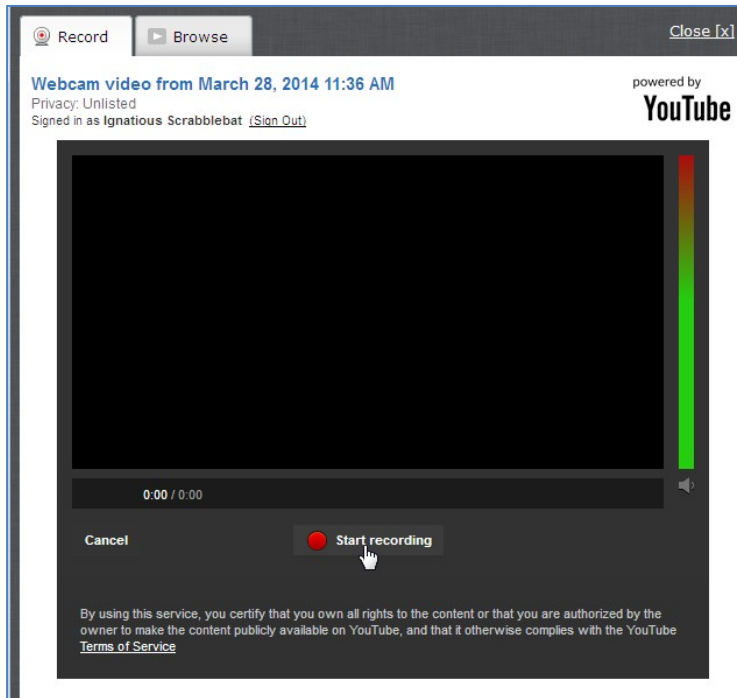
4. Click **Grant Access**.



5. Click **Record from webcam**.



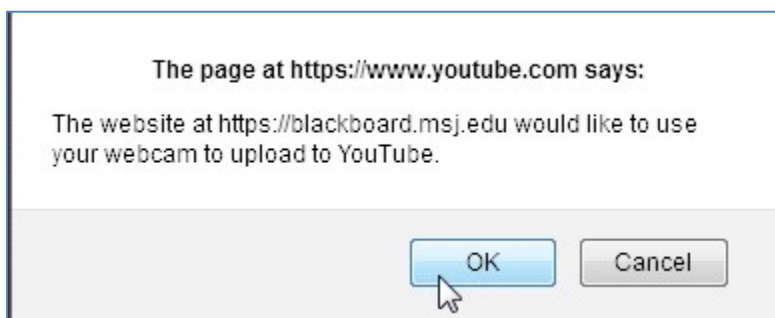
6. Click **Start recording**.



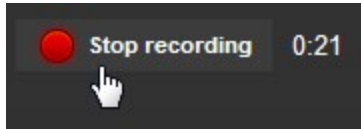
7. Click **Allow** in the Adobe Flash Player Settings window.



8. Click **OK** to allow Blackboard to upload your video to your Youtube account.



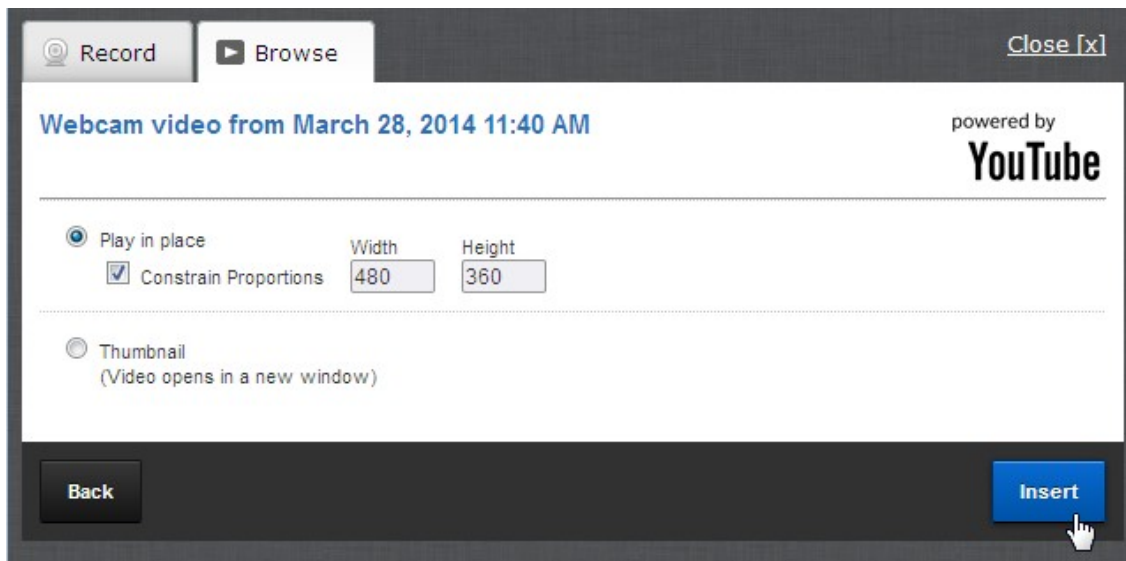
9. When you are finished recording, click **Stop recording**.



10. Click the **Upload** button.



11. Click the **Insert** button.



12. Enter a Subject.

13. A box indicating the size of the video will display in the Text Editor.

14. Enter any desired options for the content area of Blackboard (e.g.: Attach file, Duration, Date Restrictions, etc.).

15. Click **Submit** on the Blackboard page.
